Magnum, Willamette

MALT

Canadian 6-Row, Empire
Pilsen, Yellow Corn Flakes

YEAST

Wyeast 2124 Bohemian

APPEARANCE

Yellow to deep gold in color, with a substantial white head and bright clarity.

FLAVOR

This beer has a medium maltiness with a grainy flavor contributed by the heavier proteins in the 6-Row malt, which is rounded out by using yellow corn flakes. There is a balanced hop profile that offers a rustic floral aroma, and a mild but pleasant fruitiness. This beer is lagered for several weeks, making it crisp, smooth, and easy to drink.

BREWER'S NOTES

I have experimented with several versions of this beer over the years, finally landing on this recipe for our guests. Inspired by other American pilsners, this beer is partially brewed with 6-Row malt and flaked maize, similar to some pre-prohibition era beers from U.S. history.
